Don't forget the Christmas Carol Sing-along on December 17 at 3 pm in the Sanctuary, followed by treats; OR the Community Choir Carol Sing at Glen Arden at 6:30 that same evening! Let me know you're coming if possible, and come with a big smile and love to share with our oldest and wisest.

Another quick note: there will be no Tuesday organ recital on "Boxing Day," or December 26, the day after the holiday. I am taking a Tuesday off for the first time!

This year, Advent is very short, since the Fourth Sunday of Advent is also Christmas Eve. Sometimes it works out that way!

Advent was once forty days long like Lent, but was shortened to four Sundays sometime in the 9th (not 19th) century—a very long time ago. This was to emphasize that its penitential character was not as severe as that of Lent. True, there is the same purple/pink color scheme, and in liturgical churches some of the joyful texts are omitted, but the Alleluia is never dropped and the season is also marked by joyful anticipation.

Still, there is no avoiding the connection between the cradle in Bethlehem and the Cross on Calvary. Jesus came to save us by laying down His life. Martin Luther is big on this point.

The music in Advent shares in this double nature of joy and soul-preparing. As we hear concerning John the Baptist in the Gospel for December 10, "prepare the way of the Lord!" That takes some hard work. All the music during the four short weeks of Advent will reflect the joyful hard work of preparing for the coming of the Lord—a story as fresh as it is old.

Looking forward to sharing the timeless joy of Advent and Christmas with you all!



The Live Stream camera generally captures the first 4-5 (rarely 7-8) rows of the sanctuary in its feed. Normally we only see the back of your head. If you would rather stay out of camera range, please know that we do not capture the seating under the balcony (on either side) and we don't capture the back rows at all. Regarding the Children's Message: We keep the camera zoomed out. As children leave to go to Sunday school, we will pan up to the stained glass windows so no children's faces are caught on camera.


