The adult choir is done with Thursday evening rehearsals till the fall. However, the Sunday morning singing will continue. At our final session on June 15, we worked on several anthems that will carry us forward a while, and celebrated our year with "bubbly" (non-alcoholic sparkling apple juice), cookies, and assorted snacks.

Handbells are also on vacation till the fall. Thanks to them for another year of great musical growth and service.

It's fun to be a musician, and fun to sing in a choir. My own choral experience dates back quite far in my life. Though turned away from the children's choir at my parish on 22^{nd} Street, without so much as eye contact ("boys don't sing"), I joined an Irish dance group in third grade and learned quite a few classic Irish songs along with the jigs and reels. We danced and sang for our school on an "Irish Night" that spring.

Afterwards my brother and I were treated by our parents to a feast at the Blimpie on Third Avenue. We were the only two boys who had persevered all year, but we proved the point: boys *can* sing...and frankly, they should!

Later, there were high school choruses, the parish choir, summer theater, and eventually voice lessons and big choral opportunities. I have sung in the chorus for the Beethoven Ninth, the Mahler Second, the Brucker *Te Deum*, Haydn's *Creation*, the Bach *Magnificat*, several Gilbert and Sullivan operas, and more. I have even stood in the "friendly confines" of Wrigley Field and sung the national anthem as part of a choir. It's all been enormously enjoyable.

When you are really in the singing "zone" you feel like you are floating. There is a sense of pure physical joy that quickly turns into something spiritual. And no, I don't mean you run out of oxygen. I mean that you can feel the deep union, the deep marriage, of body and soul that characterizes the human person. St. Augustine says that "the glory of God is man fully alive," and surely music is a way to be fully alive!

So consider having a "bubbly" experience in our music ministry! You don't have to wait till fall. Feel free to join in on any Sunday morning you like. If you don't know the anthem you can simply join with the hymns and get comfortable. After we sing through the backlog of repertoire we will be picking up simple songs on Sunday, so you might prefer to join perhaps halfway through July or any time in August.

I hope to have news about organ recitals soon. Stay tuned for a musical summer!

The Live Stream camera generally captures the first 4-5 (rarely 7-8) rows of the sanctuary in its feed. Normally we only see the back of your head. If you would rather stay out of camera range, please know that we do not capture the seating under the balcony (on either side) and we don't capture the back rows at all. Regarding the Children's Message: We keep the camera zoomed out. As children leave to go to Sunday school, we will pan up to the stained glass windows so no children's faces are caught on camera.




