Update from the Interim Pastor Committee:

For those who are not familiar with the process, let me take a few minutes to give you an overview.

First a committee is selected to represent a cross section of the congregation - Elders, Deacons and members. Once selected, a representative from Presbytery is assigned the COM (Committee of Ministry) to join the committee meetings and assist with any questions, procedures, and with the general process.

In July, the committee held the first meeting and we have been meeting every week since then.

The process includes filing a MIF (Ministry Information Form). The MIF requires gathering church information from various reports and sources. The MIF also includes questions related to our congregation history, our mission, our vision and our future.

Once the MIF is completed, it is brought to Session for approval: The MIF was approved by Session on September 23rd.

After approval by Session, it is sent to Presbytery for approval and acceptance: Presbytery approved the MIF on October 8th.

Upon Presbytery approval, the MIF is uploaded into the Presbytery system. Then our MIF is matched with candidate's PIF (Personnel Information Form). Presbytery contacts the committee advising of candidates that meet FPC criteria. Candidates may also contact the committee directly as a self-referral.

As of this week we have received PIFs from 13 candidates. The committee continues to meet weekly. We are reviewing and evaluating all PIFs to select candidates who will move onto the next phase. The next phase is the interview process.

I hope this overview of the process has been informative. I speak for the committee, we ask for continued prayers as we move forward with this Interim Search.

Memorial Pavers

To order a memorial paver to honor or remember your loved ones, please see Pat in the church office. The cost of each paver is only \$100. We will place an order when we have 10 requests (as of now we only have one order).

Only 4 Niches Remain Available for Purchase in the Memorial Columbarium

Each niche allows for double or single interment with three purchase options:

Payment in Full = \$2,800

12-Month Payment Option = \$250 / month for 12 months (\$3,000) 18-Month Payment Option = \$180 / month for 18 months (\$3,240)

We will need to consider constructing a 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} columbarium wall soon. The estimated cost for these two new walls is \$40,000+.


